PLEASE NOTE

<u>Photos without an accompanying article or suitable information cannot be accepted.</u> Photos of general reunions or outdoor functions, unless uniquely interesting, are not considered to have readership interest.

<u>Photos should stir some interest in our readers</u> and can be of the author of the article as well as the subject of the photo: new or unusual work, special event, etc. (most group shots of members around a table would not be in this category)
